Southampton Statistics

It was estimated that there were 5,900 people living with sight loss in the city of Southampton in 2011 and this is set to increase to 6,900 by 2020.

In Southampton there are **126 visually impaired children** registered with Southampton City Council.

Each year the charity delivers information, advice and support to over 1,000 people from the ages of 3 years to 98 years old.
